As NEMRC does more reappraisals we find places that help improve the process. We feel communication is a key component to the reappraisal process. Therefore, we are adding a new process that will link the reappraisal information to a tax map.

In this example we are going to show all of the parcels in Town that we have inspected and who from our staff inspected those parcels. It also gives the Town officials an idea of how far along in the process we are at any given point. In the past someone may have manually colored a map in by hand that hung on a wall.

## How does it work?

- 1. Our Assessors fill out the 'History' tab Inspection information
- 2. Each night we back that data up and link it to the tax maps.
  - a. As we move to our new Dot Net version of the NEMRC CAMA program it can be more real time.
